Reflection FROM FR. JAKE May 17, 2024

Dear Friends of St. Lawrence Newman Center,

I am going to ask you a very straightforward question and I want *you*, the reader, to pause (like, actually pause) and *consciously think* about your real, personal answer to this question:

Would you like to receive more of the Holy Spirit, the Spirit of God Himself given at Pentecost? The same Spirit of power that animated the apostles in the Upper Room in Acts chapter 2 of Holy Scripture?

If your answer is 'no' I invite you to consider why this might be, e.g. "Why am I closed off to receiving more of God?"

If your answer is a muddled, "I guess so…" I would challenge you to say either a yes or a no but not a maybe! After all, Jesus says in Revelation 3:15: "You are neither hot nor cold! How I wish you were one or the other!"

If your answer is 'yes' in some real way then...I am going to challenge you personally to do **one practical thing** in this next week. After all, it is Pentecost Sunday this Sunday and it seems that the unleashing of the Holy Spirit favors those who are willing to risk something (embarrassment, danger, discomfort, loss, etc.) for His sake.

Here is my invitational challenge: <u>I invite you within the next seven</u> <u>days to ask someone to pray over you for receiving more of the Holy</u>. <u>Spirit.</u> This someone could be your spouse, a good friend, your priest (of course), or even someone quite random but whom you know to be a Catholic-Christian. It could be as simple as asking: "*N., this might sound a little weird, but could you pray over me for a minute for a fuller release of the Holy Spirit?*"

I am convinced that many graces are not given because we have never asked. Furthermore, I am convinced that there is a special power when we risk vulnerability with another member of the Body of Christ. Jesus says "Where two or three are gathered in my name, there I am in the midst of them." There is something about asking someone else to pray over us that is kind of risky. And yet, it is precisely that action that in the mystery of God that seems to dispose us to a fuller release of the power of God.

Are you willing to do this? If so, you might consider, on your own, doing the following in a few minutes of quiet prayer before getting prayed over:

- Repent of all your sins (silently, just take a few mins and do this from your heart)
- Recommit your life to the Holy Spirit (make it your own, be sincere)
- Ask for a further unleashing of the Holy Spirit in your life (be bold! Do not be afraid!)

May the Holy Spirit, the Spirit of light, love and power, overwhelm us this Pentecost.
